

## **Nurse's Notes**

### **Immunizations**

Somerville ISD must have a current shot record for every student that meets State requirements. If a student does not have all required immunizations they will not be allowed to attend school until they receive the delinquent immunizations.

### **Medications**

#### **Prescription Medications:**

All prescription medication must be a current prescription in its original prescribed container, and medication will **ONLY** be given as prescribed by your child's physician.

#### **Over –The-Counter (OTC):**

All OTC medications must be in original sealed container and will only be given with a note from a physician that states the frequency/dosage that is to be given to the student. OTC medications **WILL NOT** be administered for fever.

#### **As Needed (PRN): (epi-pens, asthma, diabetic etc.)**

All meds that are to be given as needed-PRN will be given as directed by physician, an action plan **MUST** be completed by physician and returned to Somerville ISD.

### **Head-Lice**

If a student is sent home with head lice they are not allowed to return to SISD until they are nit free.

### **Sick Students**

If a parent/guardian is contacted about a sick student, the student **MUST** be picked up within an hour of the notification. If contact is made and there is less than an hour of school remaining the child will only be allowed to ride the bus home if the illness is believed to not be contagious. Students must be sent home if they are vomiting or have a temperature of 100 degrees or higher. Any student that is sent home for fever can **NOT** return until they have been fever free for 24 hours without medication.
