If your place of residence is outside the boundaries of the Somerville School District **you must** complete a transfer application requesting approval for your child/children to attend Somerville Schools. A transfer application form can be picked up at the Administration Building located at 625 8th Street in Somerville, completed, and returned to the Administration Building by Thursday, May 3, 2018.

To comply with the procedures for student transfers as required by federal Court Order/Civil Action 5281, school districts in Texas may not approve transfers where the effect of such transfers will change the majority or minority percentage of the school population, based on average daily attendance in such districts, by more than one percent in either the home or the receiving district.

If your child/children were approved as transfer student(s) for the 2017-2018 school year, an application will be mailed for 2018-2019.
